- ◆ To have your vote count, do not spoil your ballot by erasing or crossing out your choice.

Question One: People's Veto

- YES Do you want to reject the parts of a new law that change the method of funding Maine's Dirigo Health Program through charging health insurance companies a fixed fee on paid claims and adding taxes to malt liquor, wine and soft drinks?
- NO

Question Two: Citizen Initiative

- YES Do you want to allow a certain Maine company to have the only casino in Maine, to be located in Oxford County, if part of the revenue is used to fund specific state programs?
- NO

Question Three: Bond Issue

- YES Do you favor a \$3,400,000 bond issue to support drinking water programs, to support the construction of wastewater treatment facilities and to leverage \$17,000,000 in other funds?
- NO

Total estimated life time cost is \$4,241,500 representing \$3,400,000 in principal and \$841,500 in interest (assuming interest at 4.5% over ten years).
