TO: John S. Anderson, a resident of the Town of Bridgton, in the County of Cumberland, State of Maine.




ARTICLE 1. To choose a moderator by written ballot to preside at said Meeting.



To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to transfer from undesignated fund balance and appropriate an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to finance the purchase of used and/or new public works equipment on terms determined by the Board of Selectmen to be advantageous to the Town and likely to reduce the Town's capital costs for public works equipment in future years.


