The total number of votes cast in all of the municipalities within Maine School Administrative District No. 61 in the affirmative on Question 1 of the Warrant and Notice of Election of the Regional School Unit referendum held November 3, 2009, relating to the financing of a school construction and renovation project by Maine School Administrative District No. 61 is 3,981, and the total number of votes cast in all of the municipalities in Maine School Administrative District No. 61 in the negative on said Question is 2,211, said votes being computed as follows:
