

WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION CALLING
MAINE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 61 REFERENDUM
(20-A M.R.S.A. §§1501-1504)

TO: Cathy Gerrish, a resident of Maine School Administrative District No. 61, a regional school unit composed of the Towns of Bridgton, Casco, Naples and Sebago, County of Cumberland and State of Maine.

TO: Laurie Chadbourne, Town Clerk of Bridgton: you are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF BRIDGTON:

You are hereby notified that a Regional School Unit referendum election will be held at the Bridgton Town Hall, 26 North High Street in the Town of Bridgton at 8:00 a.m. on November 3, 2009 for the purpose of determining the following referendum question:

Question 1. Do you favor authorizing the School Board of Maine School Administrative District No. 61 to issue bonds or notes in an amount not to exceed \$13,837,000 to renovate Lake Region High School and Lake Region Vocational Center and to construct and equip a new building on the existing Lake Region school site in Naples for the automotive and construction educational programs for Lake Region Vocational Center, and for District-wide transportation services?

The polls must be opened at 8:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
