ARTICLE 4. **Notice to Voters- Article 4 is a Non-Binding Question. The Board of Selectmen is seeking your opinion. If the voters in November support this idea a formal and legal ballot question would be put before the voters at the June 2010 election.**

The Engineer's report indicates that work should be done on the Old Town Hall located at 26 North High Street to assure it will continue to be safe and usable in the future.

Would the voters of the Town of Bridgton support borrowing up to \$400,000 for the renovations of the Old Town Hall to make the necessary improvements and restoration work as recommended by the Engineer? Either a five year note at \$89,644 per year or a ten year note at \$49,518 per year could be issued.
